**Professional Movers Union Mobilizing to Elect "Tireless Fighter for City's Working-Class"**

**Local Cites Long Track Record of Advocacy for Worker's Rights, Affordable Housing**

Today, Teamsters Local 814's executive board announces their endorsement of councilperson Ben Kallos for Manhattan Borough President. "In a crowded field with several other principled progressive candidates, says Local 814 President Jason Ide, "Kallos stands alone for being such a tireless fighter for the city's working-class, and for never being afraid to hold the city's most powerful institutions to account." "Our union's membership looks forward to hitting the streets and helping him be elected as Manhattan's next Borough President," he added.

Local 814's Secretary-Treasurer Walter Taylor also weighed in by praising Kallos' work ethic and his follow through on key issues that matter to the city's workers.
